Our staff is excited to offer fun, age appropriate games, arts and crafts, outdoor playtime, and help with homework. Y Kids Club is approved and licensed by the State of Nebraska.

PHILOSOPHY

Y Kids Club provides activities that will build character and challenge children to develop physically, mentally, and socially. All children will learn and interact in a safe and fun environment.

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

- Enrollment begins in May for the upcoming school year, and it's ongoing throughout.
- There is a \$25 enrollment fee per child, per school year.
- **Weekly registration & payment is due by each Wednesday for the upcoming week,** or a \$10 late fee applies (1 per family). Register online or at the YMCA.
- A \$1 per minute Late Pick-Up Fee applies beginning at 6:00 pm.

DHHS CHILD CARE SUBSIDY PROGRAM

If you feel you need financial assistance, the Y participates in the Child Care Subsidy program through DHHS. Our provider #03334361, and provider name is "Young Men's Christian Association."

Shayla, Kids Club Director, must have the Kids Club Enrollment paperwork, Immunization Records, and DHHS's Authorization Approval paperwork prior to starting Y Kids Club.



HOURS OF OPERATION

Y Kids Club provides after school care at Stanton Elementary School on school days, including regular 3:29 pm dismissal days, as well as 11:35 am & 1:20 pm early dismissals. Care is provided after school in the Stanton Elementary School gym until 6:00 pm, Monday-Friday. Care will **not** be available for snow days. Children must be signed out each day by an adult. Program ends at 6:00 pm.

ALL DAY CARE - Y Kids Club will offer All Day Care, 6 am—6 pm, at the Norfolk YMCA building only on scheduled Norfolk Public School Out Days and Holiday Breaks. We plan for a fun-filled day, including crafts, structured group games, activities, swimming, outside playtime, and more! Child must wear shoes, and bring a cold lunch, extra snacks, swim suit, and towel.

SUMMER - Day Camp is for children entering Grades K-6th in the fall. We offer Day Camp all 11 weeks of summer, each week has a theme and field trip. Enrollment begins each April.

RULES OF Y KIDS CLUB

- All children must show respect to the supervising staff and other children. No talking back.
- No swearing. Other improper language or gestures are not allowed.
- No fighting, teasing, or provoking others.
- All safety & discipline procedures must be followed.
- No children will be allowed to leave the premises without permission. If a child leaves the premises without permission, serious action from the discipline policy will be taken.
- All equipment and other belongings must be treated with respect.
