21ST CENTURY LEARNING GRANT

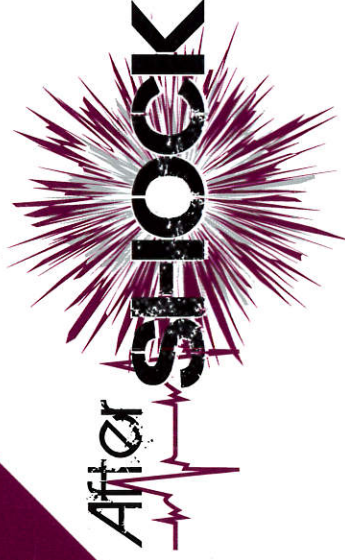
The 21st Century Learning Grant is a five year grant that will fund the program as follows:

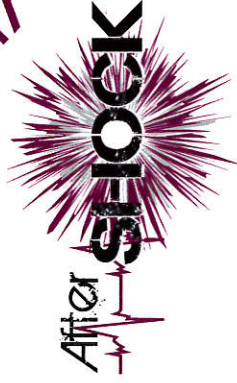
