

A TYPICAL DAY IN Y KIDS CLUB

Before Care: Parents drop off at the school at any time, beginning at 6 am (school breakfast program is available). Children can play gym games or choose from a variety of fun things to do from the activity cart.

After Care: Upon school dismissal, children report to the elementary school gym. Once attendance is taken, we serve a snack. Afterwards, we have reading/homework time, then we enjoy the rest of the afternoon with crafts, group games, activities, outdoor play, and/or free time. We have gym equipment available, as well as an activity cart filled with reading books, board games, Legos, cars, army men, Barbies, coloring pages, and more! Parents can pick up their child at any time. Program ends at 6 pm.

Our staff is excited to offer fun, age appropriate games, arts and crafts, and the opportunity to go to the YMCA to swim and participate in a wide variety of adventurous activities on a weekly basis. Y Kids Club is approved and licensed by the State of Nebraska.

PHILOSOPHY

Y Kids Club provides activities that will build character and challenge children to develop physically, mentally, and socially. All children will learn and interact in a safe and fun environment.

OBJECTIVES

Y Kids Club participants will:

- Build character and reinforce values
- Develop meaningful relationships

LOCATIONS

Y Kids Club is available for children, Grades K-4, at the following elementary schools in Norfolk (care is provided at the school):

- **Bel Air**

On Swim Days, children will be transported by bus to the YMCA and parents will pick them up at the Y on those days, by 6 pm.

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

- **Submit Enrollment Paperwork prior to your child attending the program.**
- There is a \$25 enrollment fee per child, per school year.
- **Weekly registration & payment is due by each Wednesday for the upcoming week,** or a \$10 late fee applies (1 per family). Register online or at the YMCA.
- A \$1 per minute Late Pick-Up Fee applies beginning at 6 pm.

DHHS CHILD CARE SUBSIDY PROGRAM

If you feel you need financial assistance, the Y participates in the Child Care Subsidy program through DHHS. Provider #03334361, 'Norfolk Family YMCA.' Shayla, Y Kids Club Director, must have the Y Kids Club Enrollment paperwork, Immunization Records, and DHHS's Authorization Approval paperwork prior to starting the program.



HOURS OF OPERATION

Y Kids Club provides care at the schools in the mornings from 6 am until school starts, and after school until 6 pm, Monday-Friday. Children must be signed in and out each day by an adult. Y Kids Club ends at 6 pm.

LATE START – Care will be available beginning at 6 am. Extra fees may apply.

EARLY DISMISSAL – Care will be available once school is dismissed.

SCHOOL OUT DAYS – A full day of activities will be available at the YMCA from 6 am to 6 pm, including crafts, gym games, swimming, and more! This is open to anyone in Grades K-6th. Registration and payment must be received by the Wednesday prior deadline. Child must bring a cold lunch, extra snacks, swim suit, and towel.

SNOW DAYS – The YMCA will provide care at the Y; parents will be notified by text alert. Should the day start with a regular or late start and then be called off, parents need to pick up their child and bring to the YMCA for care. No bus transportation. Lunch & swim gear need to be provided by the parent, if possible. The fee is \$28/\$38 per child.

SUMMER – Day Camp is for kids entering Grades K-6th in the fall. It's offered all 11 weeks of summer, each week has a theme and field trip. Enrollment begins each April.

SWIM DAYS

Each school will have a Swim Day about once per month, typically on a Wednesday afternoon. Schools are picked up by the YMCA bus. On Swim Days, you'll send your child to school with a swim bag, packed with a swim suit and towel. Your child must have a swim suit in order to participate in swimming. For children who want to swim in the deep end of the pool, they must pass a swim test. Kids Club will generally swim from **2:45-3:45 pm**, then we'll fill the remainder of the afternoon playing in the gym or outside. On Swim Days, you will pick up your child at the YMCA by 6 pm, not at the school. (Subject to change.)
